I am requesting funding for the Atlantic City Corridor Revitalization and Safety Project in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is Atlantic City and the project is located at Atlantic Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ, 08401.

The funding is designated for construction of safety and technology improvements, including a road diet, ADA accessible sidewalks, drainage facilities, new bike paths, clear sight lines, access a management, updated intersection synchronized signalization, wayfinding, LED streetlighting, and upgraded transit accessibility.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits:

- Improved traffic movement and safer conditions for Atlantic City's 24 million annual visitors and 39,000 residents.
