“I am requesting funding for Dennisville-Petersburg Road (CR 610) Resurfacing Improvements in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is Cape May County and the project is located at Dennisville-Petersburg Road, Dennis Township, NJ, 08214.

The funding is designated for milling and paving the Road; reconstruction of roadbed and shoulders; regrade approaches to a railroad crossing; adding stormwater runoff facilities; sidewalk reconstruction; install high visibility crosswalks; traffic calming measures; roadway restriping and raising pavement markers.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits:

- Roadway has exceeded serviceable life, has drainage and speeding issues.
- Improves biking and pedestrian mobility and safety.
- Road is classified as a major collector and provides access to Route 47. The state has plans to locate a nearby culvert and this Road will serve as the primary detour for Route 47 during this other project.
